We are learning to...

Segment words using our phonics to write a sentence.



- Say the word
- Segment on fingers
- Listen to each phoneme
- Write each phoneme down



- Capital letter to start
- Finger space
- Full stop at the end of the sentence.

Do you know the characters? What film are they from?

My examples:

The dog barks at the postman.

The cat sleeps all day long.

*Remember some words
will be spelt phonetically
such as:*

*'poastman' for 'postman'
and 'dai' for 'day'.*

▲ For an extra challenge you could add a bit more detail to your sentences by using the conjunction 'and'.

Segment each word out loud, and write the graphemes in order.

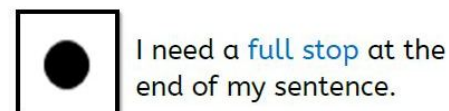
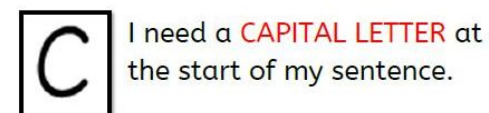
Remember to use a capital letter at the start.
