Artist Study:
Andy Goldsworthy

Andy Goldsworthy is a British artist known for his site-specific installations involving natural materials and the passage of time. Working as both sculptor and photographer, Goldsworthy crafts his installations out of rocks, ice, leaves, or branches, showing that the landscape will change. He then carefully documents the collaborations with nature through photography. "It's not about art," he has explained. "It's just about life and the need to understand that a lot of things in life do not last."



Consider your design

Do you have trees or live near a woods?



Maybe some leaves have fallen?



Collect your natural materials!

Think carefully about the colours, sizes and quantities of your materials as you select them.

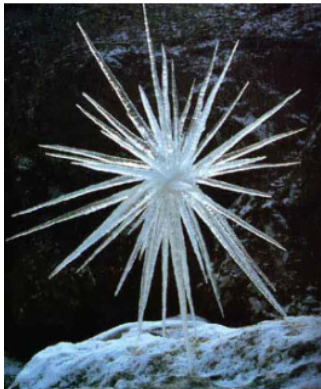


For example, this one is so effective because many of the leaves are similar colours and sizes and are therefore laid out in patterns!
