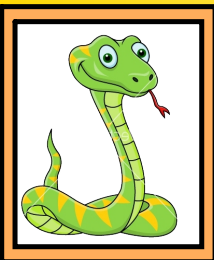

Think about what you did

Say the sentence aloud

What words do you need to write?

Start with a capital letter

Finger spaces

Handwriting - form letters correct - on the line

Y1 - Include an **and** to extend your sentence

Y2 - Include a list in one of your sentences - remember to put commas in and an and between the last two things.

End with an full stop, question mark or exclamation mark

Read your sentence - does it make sense?
