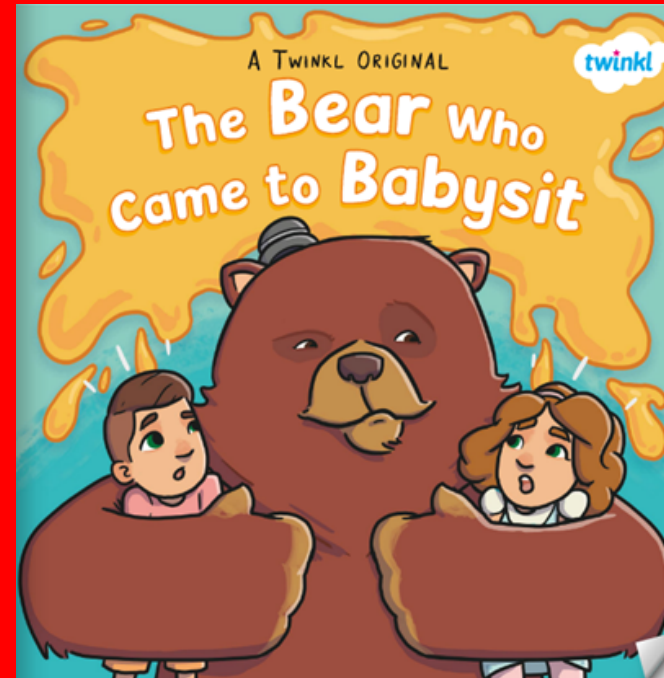


Monday - Cue in and read text

That night, the bear ran a bath. "Don't forget the bubbles!" said Bibi, handing the bear the bottle.





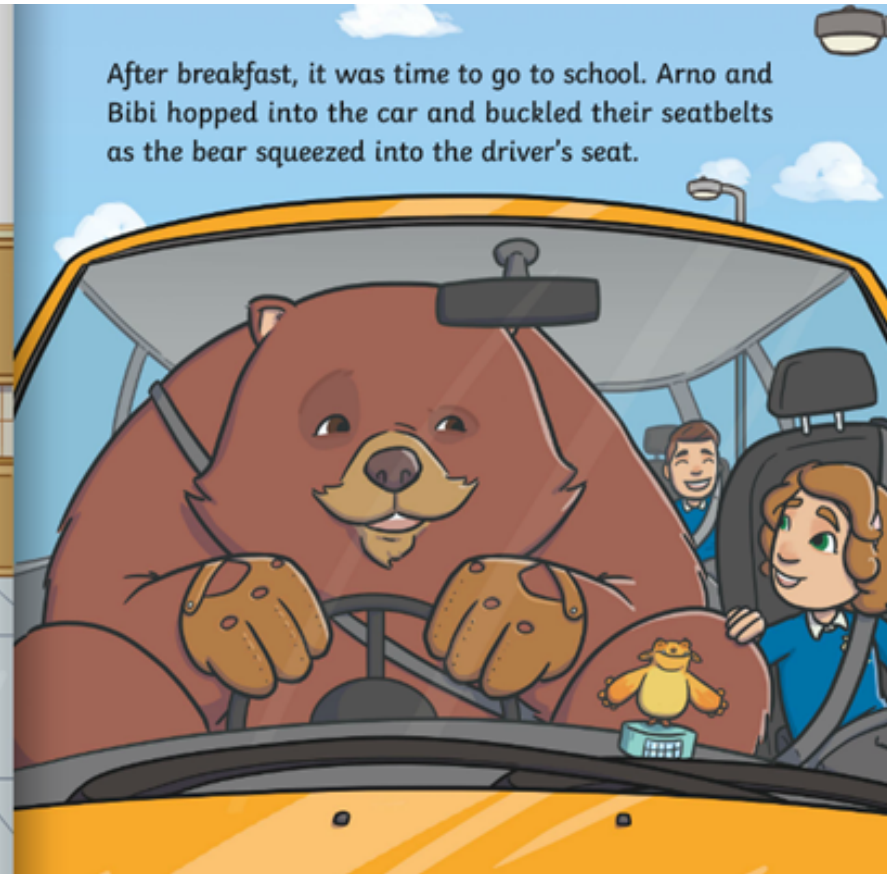


The bear gave them each some extremely sticky honey.

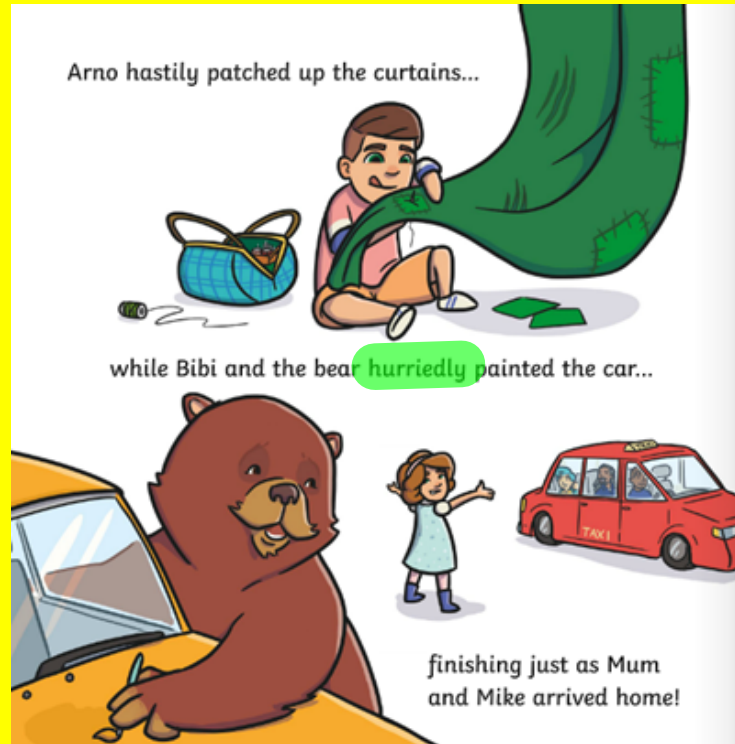

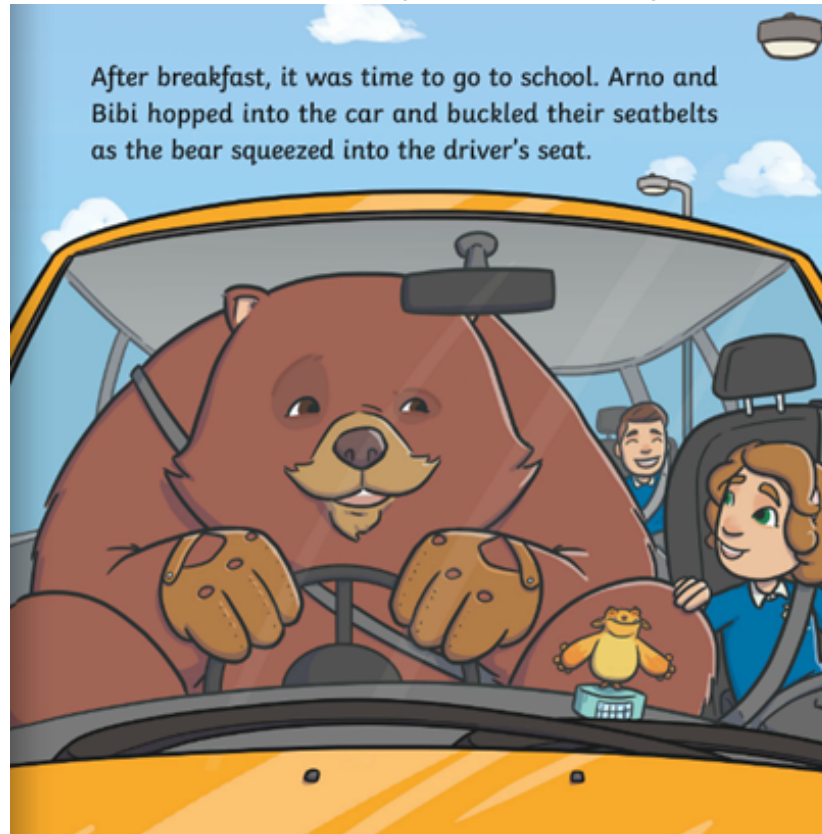
