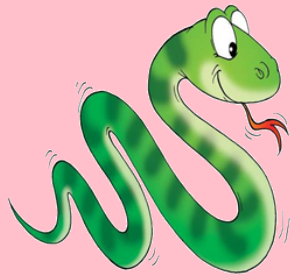

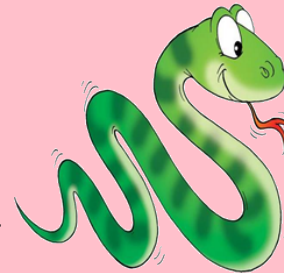


We are learning to...

segment words using our phonics.



- Say the word
- Segment on fingers
- Listen to each phoneme
- Write each phoneme down



- Capital letter to start
- Finger spaces
- Full stop at the end.

Recap on how Police Officers and Firefighters keep us safe.





Today can you think about what you do to help people?

It is now your turn. Can you write the jobs you do to help other people.

My examples:

I wash the pots and pans.

I help with the gardening.

I carefully set the table.

*Remember some words
will be spelt
phonetically
such as:
'cairfullee' for 'carefully'
'tabul' for 'table'*

For an extra challenge you could add a bit more detail to your sentences by using the conjunction 'and'.

Make sure you follow the success criteria when writing a sentence.

Success Criteria:

Segment each word out loud, and write the graphemes in order.

Remember to use a capital letter at the start.



Use finger spaces in between every word.

Can you write some tricky words?

Remember to put a full stop at the end of the sentence.
