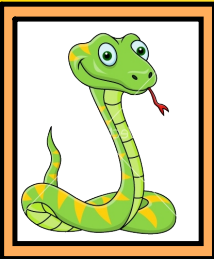

To be successful I must...

- ✓ Change the sentence from present to past
- ✓ I can add -ed to the end of the word
- I can read my sentence to check it makes sense
- ✓

What has been added to these words? What does it sound like?

licked

yell
yelled

start
started

work
worked

burn
burned

Have you heard any of these?

It shows the action is happening in the **past**.



This is called **past tense**.

Example: what did you have for lunch?

Read this sentence together:

Ed look at the book.

What is wrong?



Dee wash the car.
