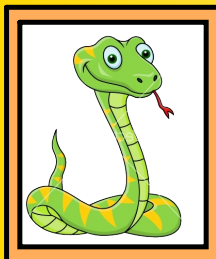

*In RE this week we have been retelling the Christmas story. We are now going to write what happened that night from the part of the donkey who carried Mary and then stayed at the stable.*



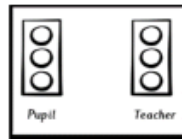

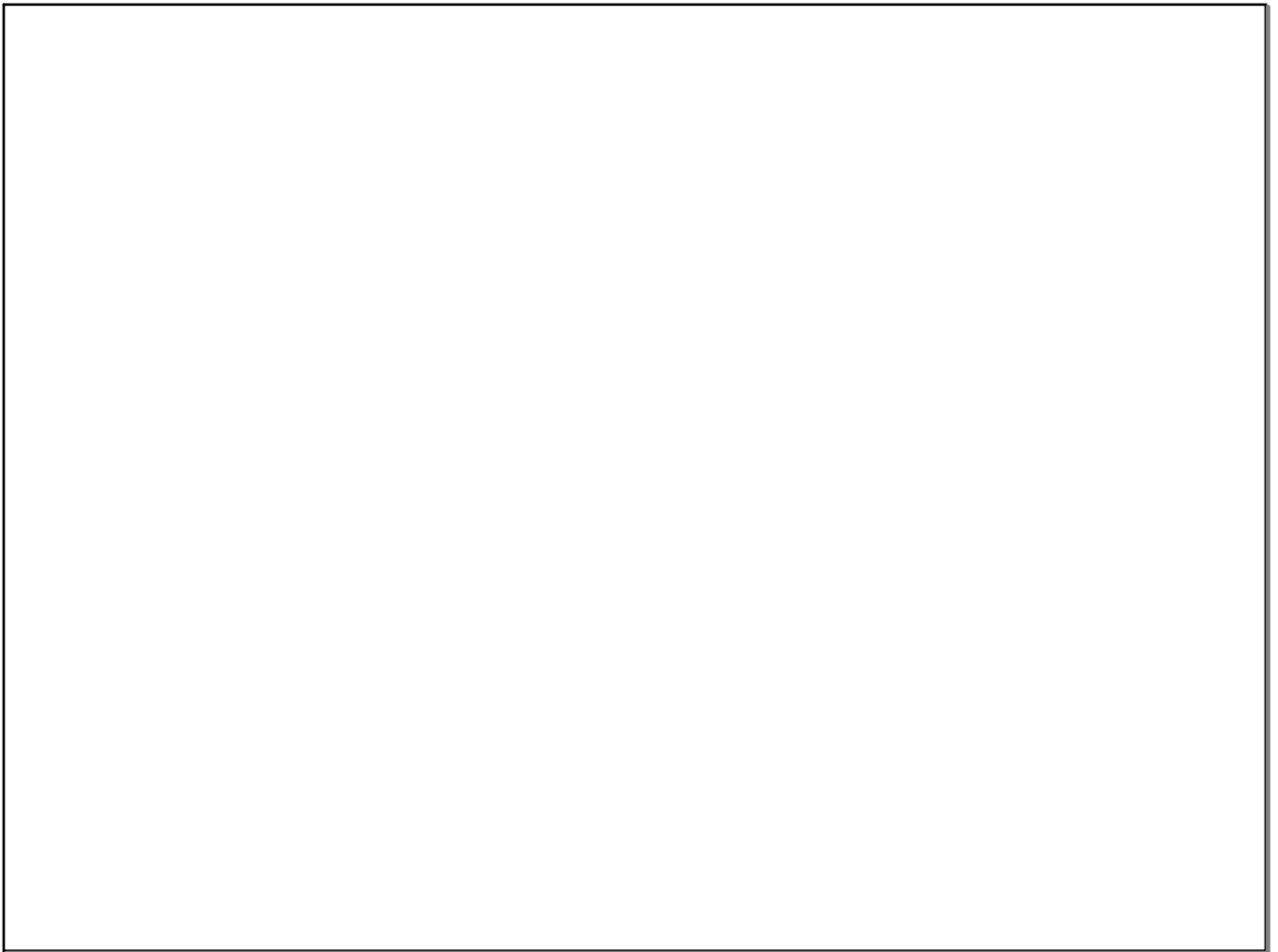
