
LO: To use 4 figure grid references.


Recap:

4 figure grid references are used to identify which square on a map something is in. Remember, the grid reference has the horizontal (across) number first, followed by the vertical (up and down) number. The reference for each square is the point at the bottom right of it.


I'm going to work through how to find the grid reference of the yellow square with you




The grid reference for this square is the reference of the bottom left corner that the arrow is pointing to.



First, write the number of the line from across the bottom of the map. 07,




Next, write the number of the line from up the side of the map to complete the reference.
