Segment words using our phonics to write a sentence.




- Say the word

- Draw a picture of Noi helping the whale.
- Write a sentence describing what is happening in the picture.

My example: Noi helped the whale.



Noi helped the whale and kept it safe.

Remember this may be spelt phonetically such as: 'helpd' for 'helped'.

 \bigwedge For a challenge you could extend your sentence by using the word 'and'.
