Segment words using our phonics to write a sentence.



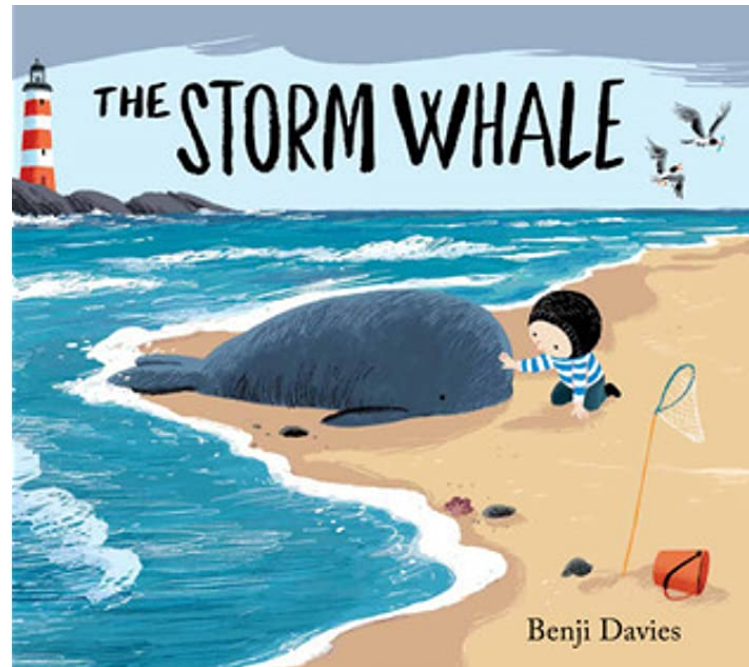
- Say the word
- Segment on fingers
- Listen to each phoneme
- Write each phoneme down



- Capital letter to start
- Finger space
- Full stop at the end of the sentence.

Activity

- Draw a picture of Noi helping the whale.
- Write a sentence describing what is happening in the picture.

My example: *Noi helped the whale.*



Noi helped the whale and kept it safe.

Remember this may be spelt phonetically such as:
'helpd' for 'helped'.

▲ For a challenge you could extend your sentence by using the word 'and'.

Success Criteria is on the next page.

Make sure you follow the success criteria when writing your sentences.

Success Criteria:

Segment each word out loud, and write the graphemes in order.

Remember to use a capital letter at the start.

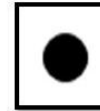
Use finger spaces in between every word.
