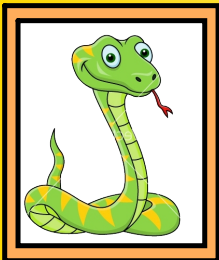

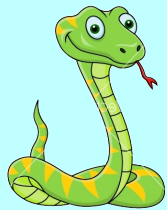

1. *Beginning- how does it start?*
2. *Build Up- describe the actions*
3. *Problem- what is the problem? Why?*
4. *Resolution- how is the problem being solved?*
5. *Ending- good or bad ending? Who for?*

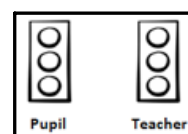
