We are learning to...

Segment words using our phonics to write a sentence.



- Say the word
- Segment on fingers
- Listen to each phoneme
- Write each phoneme down



- Capital letter to start
- Finger space
- Full stop at the end of the sentence.

*Can you tell your family member your favourite memories of being in Reception?*

*What lessons have you enjoyed?*

*Have you made lots of new friends?*

Activity

- Write three sentences describing your favourite memories Reception.
- Draw pictures of your favourite memories.


My example:

*I liked playing in the garden.*

*I liked maths lessons.*

*I liked making new friends.*

Remember this may be spelt phonetically, such as 'frends' for 'friends'.

 For a challenge you could extend your sentence by using the word 'and'.

*Success Criteria is on the next page.*

*Make sure you follow the success criteria when writing your sentences.*

Success Criteria:

*Segment each word out loud, and write the graphemes in order.*

*Remember to use a capital letter at the start.*

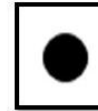
*Use finger spaces in between every word.*
