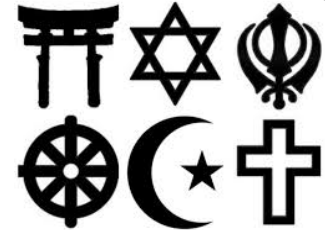

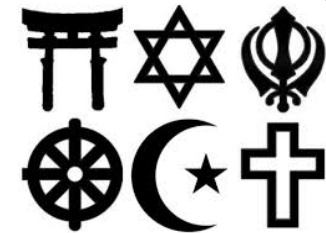
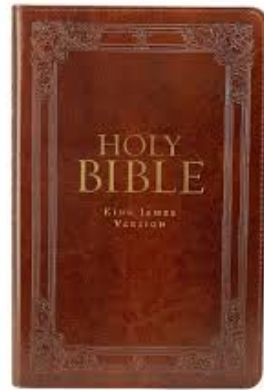
To be successful I must be able to:

- Create a special book with a family member.

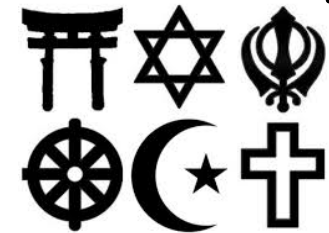


Do you remember why are each of these books special and unique?
